Of the three elements of a healthy marriage—friend, partner, and lover—friendship is the most important. Everything flows from it. But the unique aspect of a marriage is the intimate relationship between husband and wife.

Even in the best of scenarios, a healthy couple will have many meaningful friendships. They will be partners with a variety of people. But they should only have a physical intimacy with one person. Sex is a unique connection meant for husband and wife.

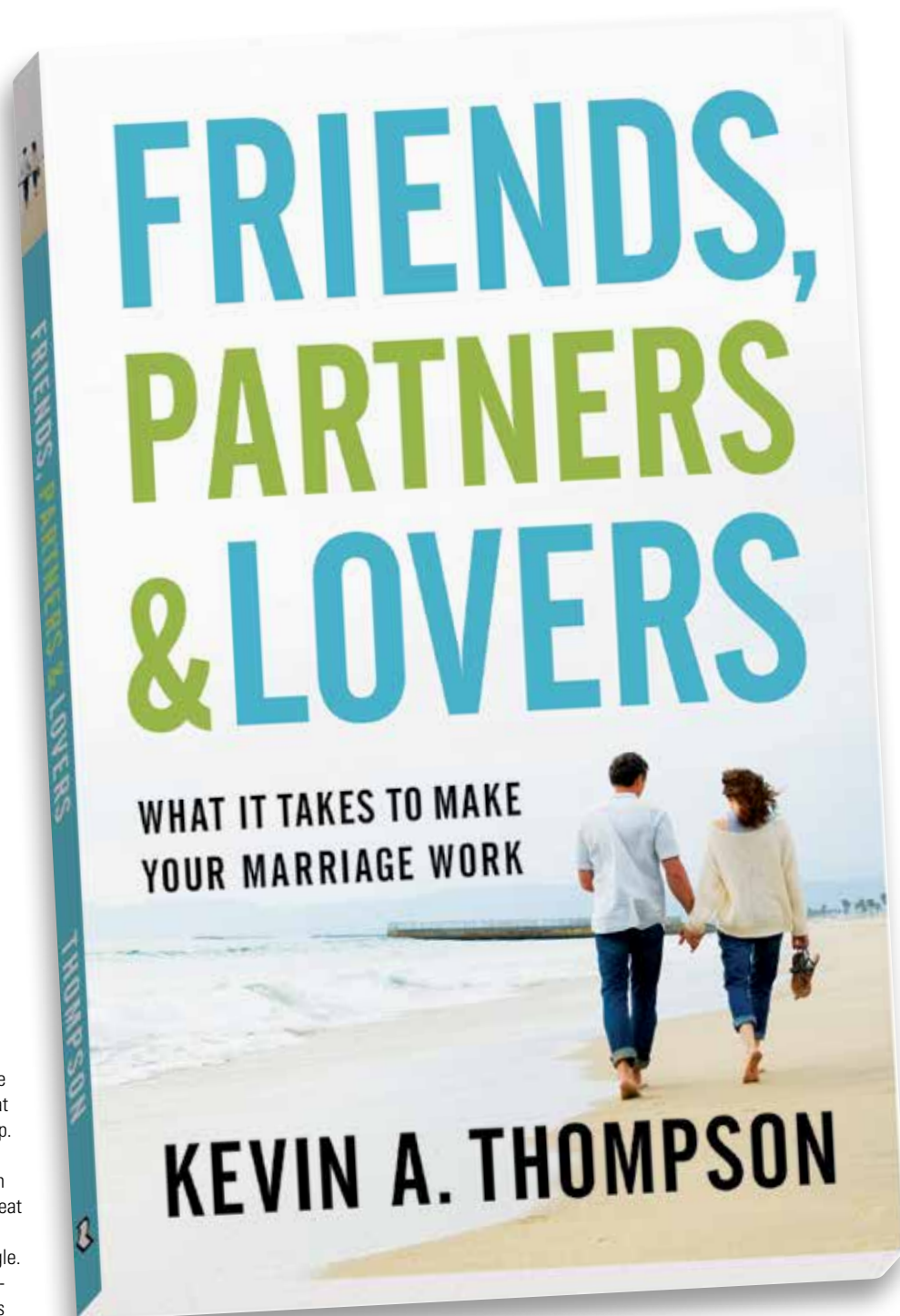
Being lovers is about more than just sex. It is an erotic dance happening between two people which intertwines with every aspect of their relationship. Sex is the key element of the dance, but it isn't the only step.

Intimacy between two people adds a critical third element to a marriage. Friendship is two people walking hand-in-hand, side-by-side through life. As friends, you always know someone is by your side. Partnership is two people living life back-to-back, always scanning the horizon for potential threats or opportunities. Lovers are two people standing face-to-face, looking each other in the eye. When you are lovers, you always know someone sees you and loves you.

The intimate side of a marriage relationship can be a deeply meaningful aspect of life. To feel cherished, valued, desired, and loved can assist a person in becoming fully alive. Yet because of shame, guilt, insecurity, and the evil potential of humanity, this aspect of marriage is fraught with peril.

Whenever I speak with couples before their wedding, I try to get an idea of what their expectations are for the relationship. Expectations often determine outcomes. With the right expectations, a couple can navigate the marital relationship with great success. With the wrong expectations, even the best of relationships will struggle.

The biggest misconception young couples have of what marriage will be like is the expectation that sex will be easy.

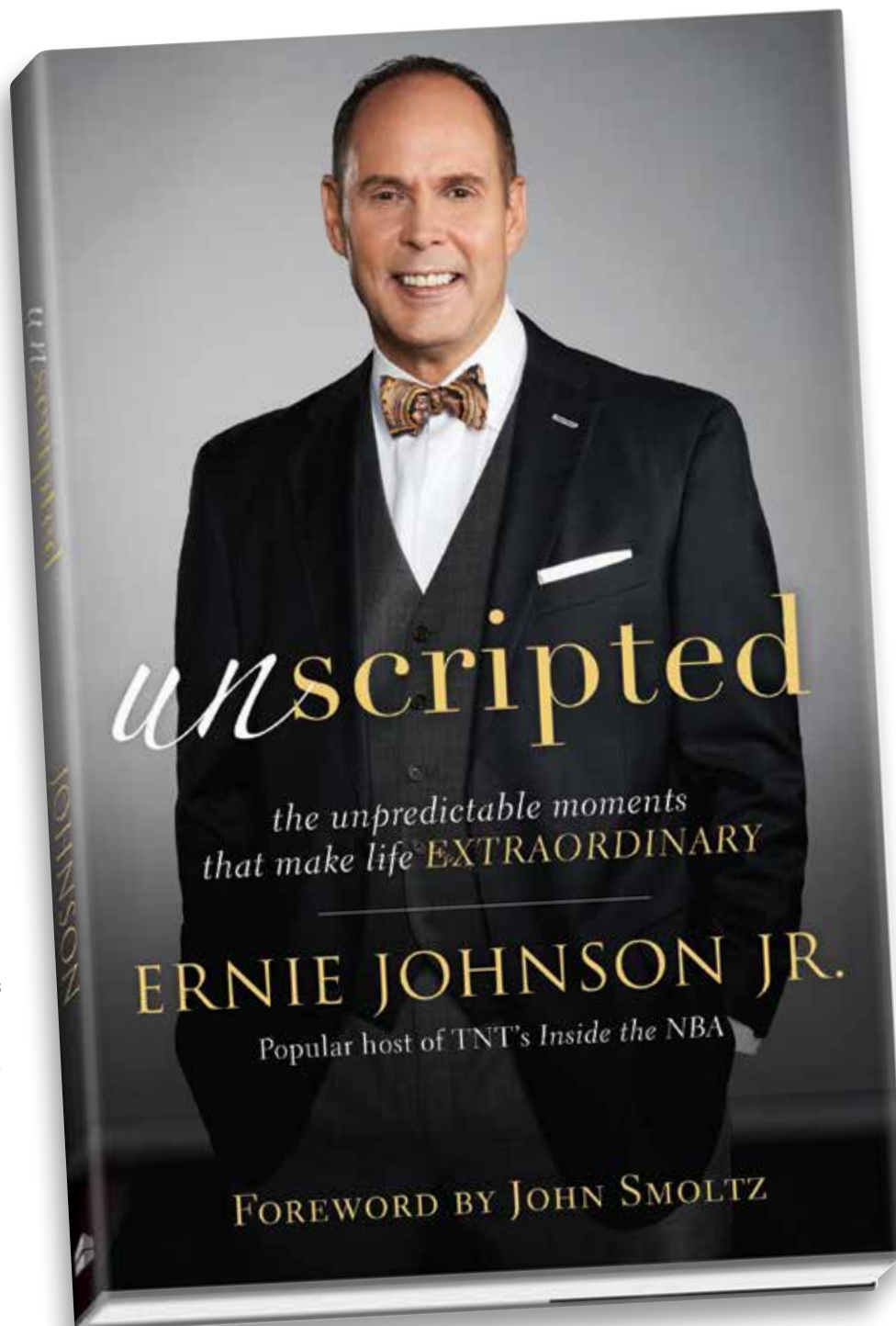
EXCERPT

Cheryl left for Romania on May 16 and settled into a small apartment in Bucharest. Enlisting the help of a cab driver named Sorin Decu, who also served as her interpreter, she made her first visit to an orphanage in a village outside Bucharest. On May 21, on one of those rare occasions when we were able to secure a phone line, Cheryl detailed that visit for me. As she waited in the lobby a nurse brought out a child. It was not an eight-month-old girl, but rather a boy, not quite three years old. He had been abandoned in a park at birth. He could not walk. He could not speak. On the other end of the phone my wife was having trouble speaking too. She was in tears.

"Hon, I met this little boy today. The first child I saw. The nurse told me 'Do not take. Boy is no good.' Er, he has so many issues, he's so much more than we said we could handle, but I don't know if I can go the rest of my life wondering what happened to him."

Her words hung there, demanding a response, for ten seconds, with neither of us speaking. Sometimes you are captured, even on a scratchy telephone call from halfway around the world, not just by the words you're hearing but by *how* they're spoken. These words were coming from some inner recess of Cheryl's heart, some place not easily accessed. Some place for which only an abandoned, hopeless Romanian orphan has the key. Suddenly all of those things we had talked about, and all those things we had written in the required adoption paperwork about the severity of a child's condition we would be willing to take on, became secondary.

"Then bring him home."

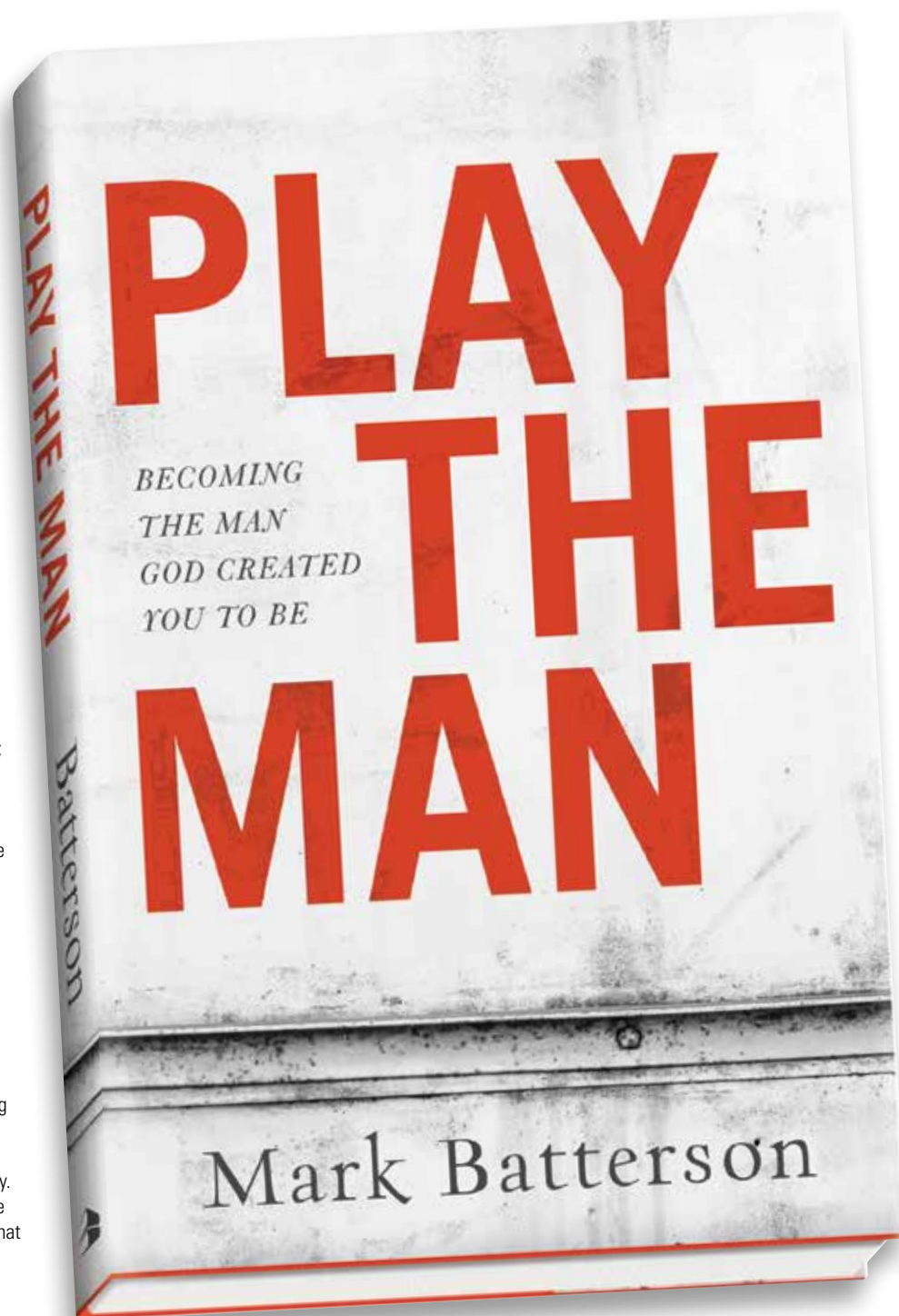
"Eighty and six years have I served Him," said Polycarp. "And He has done me no wrong! How then can I blaspheme my King who saved me?"

A Biblically-Based Call to Unity



Unity in the gospel is essential to the witness of the church. Yet that unity was tested by the release of two documents, *Evangelicals and Catholics Together* and *The Gift of Salvation*, which appeared to surrender the historic doctrine of *sola fide* (faith alone). In response, Christian leaders released a statement called *The Gospel of Jesus Christ: An Evangelical Celebration*.

Throughout Scripture, God reveals himself as the great I Am. He does not define himself with reference to any thing, person, or trait. He *is*, and that is enough. Women find themselves in a far different situation. When we introduce ourselves, we typically describe ourselves in terms of our relationships (the wife, mother, daughter, sister, or friend of someone else) or in terms of our accomplishments (our title, position, education, or accolades). When our identity is wrapped up in these external things, we inevitably (and exhaustingly!) strive to prove ourselves worthy of love, attention, or affirmation.

God never meant for us to focus on whether we are “enough,” whether we measure up. He made us—every piece of us—to *be* just as he *is*. Jerusha Clark discovered this while exploring Jesus’s seven powerful “I am” statements recorded in the Gospel of John. She invites women to join her in embracing the life and truth of these words, relishing the freedom of an identity fixed on Christ alone while leaving behind fear, bitterness, busyness, and toxic thoughts that steal our joy and limit our power.

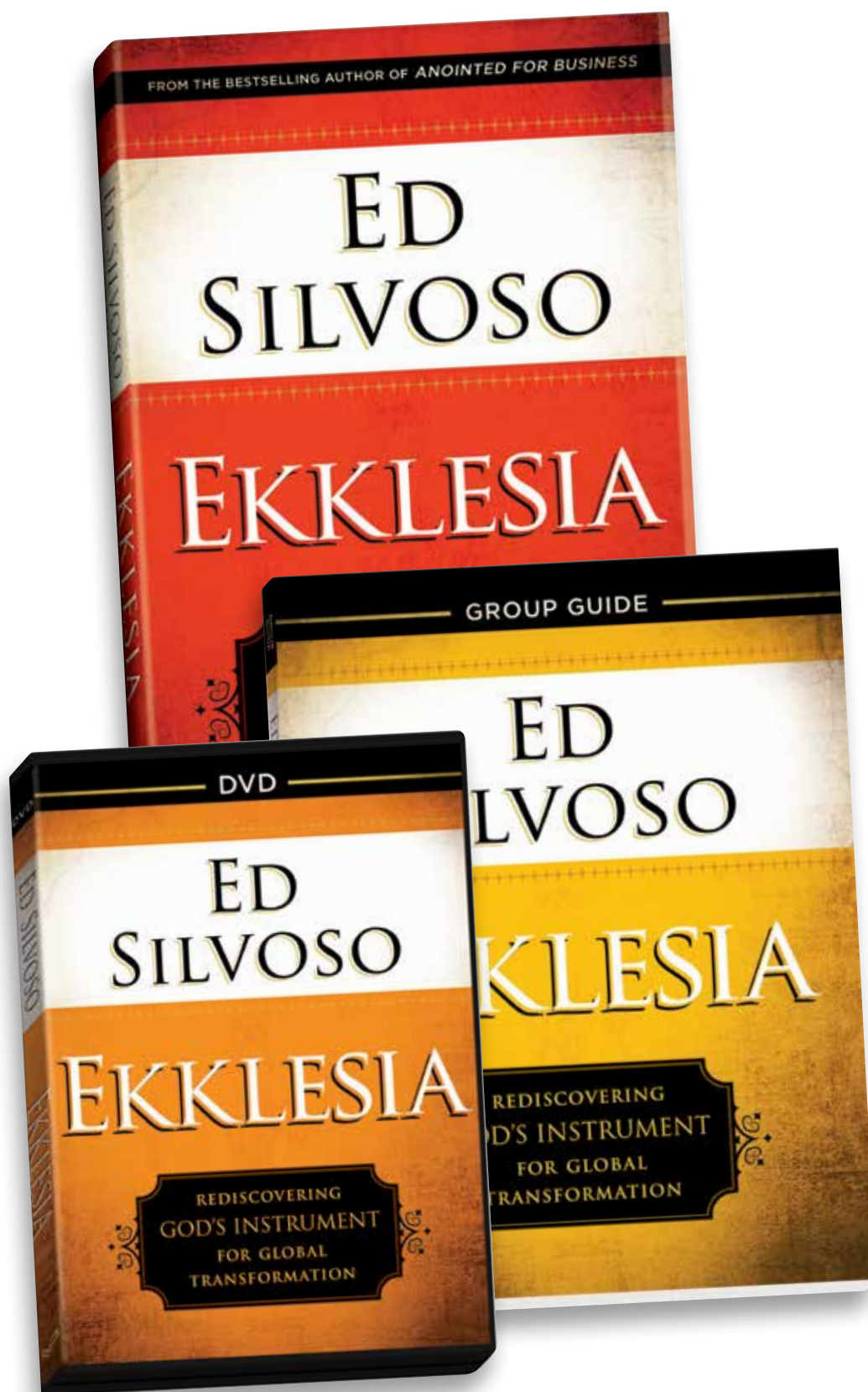
EXCERPT

It is revealing that Jesus did not state, "I will build my Temple" or, "I will build my synagogue"—the two premier Jewish religious institutions. When the moment came to launch his redemptive agency, Jesus instead declared that he would build his *ekklesia*, choosing a term that, in the Roman Empire and in subjugated Israel, embodied a secular governmental institution.

He did not discard everything that went on in the Temple or in the synagogue; he included key dimensions of both in his *ekklesia*. From the Temple he kept the indwelling presence of God, and from the synagogue the central role of the Scriptures and the regular fellowship of its members.

Where those two differ from the *ekklesia*, however, is in the area of organization, location, and mobility. The Temple and the synagogue functioned in buildings that *members* had to go to on specified occasions, whereas the *ekklesia* was a mobile people forum that operated 24/7 in the marketplace for the purpose of impacting *everybody*.

By selecting the *ekklesia* instead of the Temple or the synagogue, Jesus chose an agency better suited to succeed, not just in religious Israel, but also in pagan society, since his ultimate objective was not to reproduce or expand religious structures but to disciple nations by transforming the very fiber of society.
